10 Simple Conversation Starters



Jalk About:




Something you saw on the news that made you think of God or made you want to pray for the person.







Something you wrote in your journal or read in a blog that either had to do with God or made you think of him.








A family matter with extended relatives that is making you want God's guidance (make sure the kids won't tell the relatives).

Your latest tidbit about America's schools, standardized testing, bullying, etc., and how you perceive what God thinks of it.






Something you prayed about for yourself or your family, even if it doesn't involve the kids directly.
